Scienceinsport-Trek Riders Wilkinson & Bibby Selected for World MTB Championships

The Great Britain Team has announced its line-up for the 2007 World Mountain Bike Championships, to be held in Fort William, Scotland on 3 - 9 September and included in the team are Scienceinsport-Trek riders Ian Wilkinson and Ian Bibby.

Wilkinson's selection for the GB team comes 7 years since he last rode for the team when he was part of the then named World Class Performance Plan and 10 years since he rode his 1st World Championship as a Junior. This is great reward for his results in the British Mountain Bike National Series this season and his Silver medal in the recent MTB National Championship. He will ride in the Elite mens race.



Bibby who is part of the British Cycling Academy programme is the country's top Under 23 rider and has had what has been described as a "breakthrough year" this season with his first win in the Elite ranks and winning the Under 23 National Championship. He goes into the World Championships with hopes of making a similar impact on the International scene in the Under 23 event.
